WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW:

• THEATRE IS AN INTENSIVE EXPERIENCE. If you have never been in a show, the rehearsal process and production week can be very time consuming. If your child is involved in another other activity that is more than once a week, you should consider not committing to a production.

• COMMITMENT:

 This should be your main extracurricular activity.
 When you or your child miss a rehearsal, it impacts the entire cast.

HOW OFTEN WILL I REHEARSE?

- 3-5 times a week to start. Will increase closer to performance time.
- Unexcused conflicts will result in loss of lines, role, and/or affect future casting.
- WHO SHOULD ATTEND THE FIRST REHEARSAL? EVERYONE!
 All cast members will be expected to attend the first rehearsal unless approved by the director.
- WHAT IS THE COST? Participation is free for Bellevue residents. Non-Bellevue residents pay \$150. You will also be asked to provide jazz shoes for your child.
- WHAT DO I DO? It all depends on the age of the actor. Refer
 to the chart on the right for the specific steps for each age
 range.
